About Indian Statistical Institute



Prof. Prasanta Chandra Mahalanobis Founder of Indian Statistical Institute

he Indian Statistical Institute (ISI) was founded in 1931 by Professor P.C. Mahalanobis as a learned society. housed in the Statistical Laboratory of Presidency College. The Institute has flourished as a unique institution devoted to research and training, and applications of statistics in natural and social sciences. The institute gained the status of an Institution of National Importance in 1959 and currently stands as an institute of worldwide repute in the field of Statistics. Mathematics, Computer Science, and Quantitative Economics. renowned for the world-class quality of faculty and the outstanding caliber of its students. ISI is an autonomous institute with the Ministry of Statistics Programme Implementation (MoSPI) of the Government of India with its Headquarters at Kolkata with four centres located in Delhi. Bangalore, Chennai, and Tezpur.

Research in statistics and related disciplines is the primary activity of the institute. Teaching activities are undertaken mainly in Kolkata, Delhi, Bangalore, Chennai, and Tezpur. The seven research divisions are Applied Statistics Biological Sciences Computer & Comm. Sciences, Physics Farth Sciences, Statistics & Mathematics, Social Sciences, SOC & OR, ISI offers bachelor and masterlevel degree programs in Statistics. Mathematics, Computer Science, and Quantitative Economics. The Institute also offers two one-year diploma programs, namely Post Graduate Diploma in Statistical Methods & Analytics (PGDSMA) and PG Diploma in Applied Statistics (PGDAS), ISI alumni include eminent academicians and researchers. In recent years, a high percentage of ISI alumni have contributed to the fields of analytics. software, and the banking and finance industry.



About ISI North-East Centre

The North-Fast Centre of the institute at Tezpur was inaugurated on July 23, 2011 by Shri Pranab Mukheriee, the Union Finance Minister and Chairman of the ISI council. This is the fourth centre of ISI, joining the existing centres in Delhi, Bangalore, and Chennai, The North-East Centre offers a one-year Post-Graduate Diploma in Statistical Methods and Analytics. The North-East Centre is actively involved in training & research. The major research units of the centre are Applied and Official Statistics Unit, Socioeconomic Research Unit and Theoretical and Applied Sciences Unit. The faculty at this centre holds interest in diverse fields of research including Remote Sensing, Environmental Sciences, Applied Economics, Theory of Singularities, Macro econometrics, Social Epidemiology, Auction Theory, Survival Analysis, Credit Risk using Copulas, Machine Learning, and Data Science, It is envisaged that the North-East States will be able to improve their Official Statistical System with help from this centre. The centre aims to create a pool of scientific personnel with strong Statistical background, that will be helpful in many areas like Planning, Forecasting, and Model Building, Data Analysis,

Post Graduate Diploma in Statistical Methods and Analytics

The course is intended to provide students with a comprehensive and rigorous training in basic theory and applications of Statistical Methods and Analytics, in addition to some exposure to Mathematics and Computational Techniques. The students are exposed to data handling using R and Python packages. The programme is so designed that on successful completion, the students will be able to take up jobs in industries and government departments where applications of statistics and data analytics are required.

The one-year programme consists of a total of 10 courses. There are five courses in the first semester and four courses plus a one-course project on data analytics supervised by a faculty in the second semester. This helps the students have some hands-on experience with real world data-driven projects. The course is run at the ISI NEC campus at Tezpur and ISI Chennai campus, where the selection is through a national level exam followed by an interview.



Navigating Tezpur

Air connectivity



Tezpur has its own domestic airport named as Salonibari Airport, Tezpur. It is well connected to flights from Kolkata, Guwahati, Lakhimpur and Pasighat by Alliance Air. The nearest International Airport from Tezpur is Lokpriya Gopinath Bordolol International Airport, Guwahati, roughly 165 Kms from Tezpur.

Railways



Operational railway station in Tezpur is Dekar Gaon, that provides connectivity to major railway stations like Guwahati. Rangapara is another railway station 25 Kms from Tezpur.

Tezpur is 63 Kms from Nagaon, 75 Kms from Udalguri, 162 Kms from Guwahati, 163 Kms from Itanagar, 206 Kms from East Kameng and 263 Kms from Sagali via Assam State Road Transport Corporation (ASRTC) and some private travel services.
